Essential forest operations will be carried out in this area over the coming weeks. We will try and keep disruption to a minimum and we apologise for any inconvenience caused.

This is a thinning operation as part of a PAWS (planted ancient woodland site) restoration to allow the remaining native trees to grow to maturity and improve wildlife habitats.
